


THRIVENT FINANCIAL IN SOUTH DAKOTA



★ FUNDRAISER FOR NURSING HOME A SUCCESS

Thrivent members worked with the Kadoka Nursing Home Association to put on a holiday festival and dinner to raise funds for the Kadoka Nursing Home. Proceeds from the event were used to cover the cost of repairs to the facility, which has been around for more than 60 years and currently provides care to about two dozen senior citizens in Kadoka.

★ SPAGHETTI DINNER BENEFITS YOUNG FAMILY



Raising a child can be expensive in the best of situations. But when a baby is born early, the medical bills can quickly pile up and overwhelm the new parents. Thrivent members from Hyde and Hand counties decided to help a young couple with the medical expenses for their premature baby. Thrivent members and others in the community put on the spaghetti dinner benefit, which raised more than \$12,000 to help ease the family's financial burdens.

★ HELPING FARM FAMILIES KEEP WHAT MATTERS

A workshop developed by Thrivent, called Keeping the Farm in the Family, was held in Watertown. The hour-long workshop provided information to farmers on how to make sure their business stays in the family. Some of the topics covered included: identifying and overcoming transition obstacles; protecting assets today and in the future; and developing a plan to smoothly transition the farm and maintain family harmony.

Every house symbol on this map indicates a site where one or more homes have been or are being built through Thrivent Builds with Habitat for Humanity. Since 2005:

- Thrivent has committed **\$240 million** and **5.2 million hours** to build or repair more than **4,975** homes in the U.S. and around the world.
- Volunteers have helped more than **21,000** families and individuals.
- **46** homes have been built in South Dakota.
- **2** more South Dakota homes will be built in 2017.
- Construction is planned for more than **75** additional U.S. homes by the end of 2017.
