

Job Description – Information Systems Administrator

- Network Administrator
 - Responsible for the daily performance and availability of WSA's network.
 - Analyze network and recommend upgrades / changes.
- Information Technology
 - Ensure proper functioning of the information processing system and oversees necessary upgrades.
 - Ensure computer equipment, hardware and software are updated to meet WSA's needs.
- Information Systems Security
 - Responsible for developing and managing Information Systems security, including disaster recovery, database protection and software development.
 - Ensure all applications are functional and secure.
- Systems Programming
 - Review, analyze, develop, install and modify computer operating systems including encoding, testing, debugging and documenting programs.
- Website & Telephone Communications
 - Responsible for development, implementation and maintenance of WSA's website.
 - Oversee the development of web content and maintenance of web server.
 - Liaise with telephone communication provider to ensure WSA's telephone communication needs are met.
- Actuarial Support
 - Oversee calculation of product premiums and reserves and work in conjunction with WSA's Consulting Actuary to ensure that such calculations are in accordance with regulations and standard actuarial practices.
